A large, white skinned bulb streaked with purple that contains many small cloves. Vigorous and well adapted to summer heat. Widely grown around Gilroy, CA - the "garlic capitol" of the world.



INCHELIUM RED OGA801

From the Colville Indian Reservation in Incelium, WA. Produces large 3"+ bulbs with 8-20 good sized cloves. Has a mild, but lasting flavor with a hint of hot. Stores well - flavor increases in storage! Won "Very Best of Softnecks" in a Rodale taste-test.

ITALIAN LATE OGA402



Light colored skin covers cloves which tend to be fat and round. The extra-tight skin makes this variety excellent for storage and braiding. Matures later than Early Italian Purple and tends to be somewhat smaller in overall size.

SILVER ROSE OGA602

Bright white skin covers 12-15 rose-colored cloves. This is the best storing garlic; especially when braided. Like all Silverskin garlic, this variety is frequently planted in the spring. Very popular in the western and southern areas of the US as well as in France and Italy.



NOOTKA ROSE OGA311



From the San Juan Islands in Washington state. This variety has a medium to large bulb size with 15-20 mahogany-red streaked cloves. Strong flavored and great for braiding.
