FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What products do you offer?

We offer one stop shopping for non-GMO seeds and hardgoods. Potatoes, garlic, onions, shallots, asparagus roots, strawberry roots, onion transplants, seed racks, garden seeds, organic and heirloom products, seeders, fertilizer, cover crops, gardening apparel and so much more.

How much seed comes in each package when I order a case?

These are approximations:

8 tubers per package (24 packages per case)

60-80 onion sets per package (24 packages per case)

3 heads garlic per package (24 packages per case)

3 cloves Elephant garlic per package (24 packages per case)

5-6 shallots per package (24 packages per case)

50-60 onion transplants per bundle (15 bundles per case)

What's the difference between onion sets and onion transplants?

Onion sets are small bulbs - these look like a miniature version of the onions you would find at the store. Due to the high sugar content, we have limited ship dates which are explained on the previous page. Onion transplants look like green onions when they are shipped to you. They are already growing green tops, making it easier for your customers to plant.

I am located in the Southern states and our customers plant in January, when can I get my perishables shipped to me?

We begin harvesting our product in the fall (October-November). We highly recommend you have your order shipped immediately after we harvest. You can store your product and display them when it is convenient. Our coldest months are January and February and the mountain passes make it difficult to ship in the winter.

How do I receive price breaks?

Price breaks are explained n page 7 on the pricing page. For example, you may order bulk potatoes in increments of 50 pounds and receive a break at 100 pounds. for a single variety. Lesser quantitities are available, but are only offered at retail pricing.

What classifies a Wholesale customer?

A wholesale customer must have a store front to sell Irish Eyes products - this includes but is not limited to nurseries, grocery stores, hardware stores, etc. The products sold are unaltered in any way. If our products are grown for future sales, contact us about becoming a Market Grower - see below.

I do not meet your guidelines as a Wholesale customer. What other programs do you offer?

If you are a farmer, we offer a Market Grower program. You must plant Irish Eyes product and sell the starts or your harvests at markets or to restaurants. If you do not meet those guidelines, you qualify as a retail customer, and you will be able to place your order at anytime on our website www.irisheyesgardenseeds.com

While we have designated webpages with updated availability, please keep in mind that ordering on our website is currently ONLY available to retail customers. If you are a Wholesale or Market Grower customer, you will not receive the discounts and may be charged tax.

STORAGE INFORMATION

POTATOES: Store in a cool, dark place with good ventilation. The ideal temperature is 35°F-40°F. Humidity is good for potatoes; if it is too dry they will dry out. DO NOT store in refrigerators or airtight containers. Florescent lights will make potatoes turn green. Some chitting is good.

GARLIC: Store in a cool place away from sunlight. Garlic needs to breathe, so keep it in a ventilated place. DO NOT store in refrigerators.

ONION SETS & SHALLOTS: Store bulbs in a cool, dry place. Too much humidity will cause them to mold. DO NOT store next to potatoes as this will make your potatoes sprout quicker.

ONION TRANSPLANTS: If you are storing for an extended period of time, unbundle transplants and lay out in a cool, dry, dark place. Brown or dry looking onions are still fine to plant. Trim tops before displaying to your customers.

STRAWBERRY ROOTS: Store in a cool, dark place. You may mist the roots if they appear to be drying out. Keep them in a ventilated area.

ASPARAGUS ROOTS: Roots need to be stored in a cool, dry, dark place with plenty of ventilation. Moisture will damage the roots and cause them to mold.

Blue Belle is a mid season potato with yellow skin and purple splashes around the eyes and medium yellow flesh. Oval tubers with shallow eyes. Great when roasted, boiled, baked or mashed. Resistant to powdery scab, splitting and silver scurf. Moderate storage.

Clavella is a beautiful, mid season, large oval, South American variety with mottled red and white skin, deep white eyes and white flesh. Keeps extremely well in storage and has out produced many other potato varieties.





Viking Purple is a beautiful potato with smooth dark purple skin and violet splashes with pure snow white flesh. They are great for mashing with excellent flavor. These very early potatoes store well and are drought resistant. This high-yielding potato was developed at North Dakota State University in 1962.

Red Pontaic is the #1 red every year! This large round potato has thin, dark-red skin, deep eyes, and crisp white flesh. Excellent for mashed potatoes and boiling but not for baking. Heat-tolerant, long-storing and high-yielding, it will grow in heavy soil. Well suited for growing in wire cages. One precaution about this variety: the skin is so thin it should be allowed to cure and firm up for a week or two in the ground after the vines die back.









Produces high yields of medium to large tubers with smooth, thin, red skin and shallow eyes, white flesh and great flavor. Good storage with moderate resistance to scab. Developed at North Dakota State University for northern climates.

Russet skin, shallow eyes and white flesh are characteristics of Russet Burbank. Tastes great baked, fried or boiled. This long storing and scab resistant potato needs a consistent moisture supply. Most widely grown potato in the United States, originating from Luther Burbank's early plant breeding. This is the potato that made Idaho famous!



Oblong with white flesh and russeted skin. Noted for having 20% higher protein content than most potatoes. Very high in Vitamin C. Large, uniform, Idaho russet type. High yields of large tubers. Good flavor and texture and excellent storage. Scab resistant.



First late blight resistant russet to be released. This late season potato is high yielding, lightly russeted, suitable for frying and is excellent as a fresh market baker. Oblong with white flesh. Stores well.



Released in 1981, this medium to large sized tuber has reddish purple flowers and is one of the heaviest yielding russets. It is excellent for baking and french fries and it's one of the best storage potatoes. Resistant to scab and necrosis but susceptible to blackspot and hollow heart.



A high yielding tuber developed for coastal Northwest Washington. Produces large, uniform and disease resistant potatoes.

3 Tips for Selling Potatoes

- 1. Know your customers' needs and wants. Having a good understanding of the local growing season and conditions is important. You will be better able to guide customers in selection and help them have a successful yield.

Inform Your Customers About Starting Seed Potatoes Off Right!

If you received sprouted potato seeds, this is great! If you haven't, no worries - they just need a boost. You must chit your seed potatoes before planting them.

For chitting, the method is simple: spread the seed tubers in open-top crates, boxes or flats, one layer deep with the "seed end" facing up. (If you closely observe a seed potato, you'll notice that one end was attached to the plant, the other end has a larger number of eyes from which the sprouts emerge. This end with the eye cluster is called the seed end.) Keep the flats in a warm place (70 degrees F.) with medium light levels. The warmth stimulates the development of strong sprouts. Do not cut the tubers before they sprout.

Now, that your potatoes have sprouted you are ready to cut up your large potatoes with a clean, sharp knife. As a general rule, the larger the seed piece, the larger the crop both in terms of size of individual potatoes and overall yield. On the other hand, the larger the seed pieces used, the more seed it takes to plant a given area. However, at a minimum, each piece should contain two or more strong eyes.

The secret: dust your newly cut potatoes with Fir Bark Dust; it's a natural fungicide to guard against scab and reduce the threat of infection by bacteria or fungus. Simply give the pieces a light dusting in a bag or bucket. Then allow them to "heal over" for at least 24 hours before planting. Do not put in direct sunlight; avoid shriveling the seed pieces, which will weaken them. Once dusted, treated potatoes may be held up to one week.




