We provide our customers with a large variety of seed potatoes. Potatoes are very temperature sensitive, therefore our shipping is weather dependent. We factor in the weather at the farm and the temperatures en route to the destination. We also take mountain pass closures into consideration. Typically we ship potatoes in October to November and mid February until July or when stock runs out. We will push back your delivery if we deem it unsafe to ship our product without the risk of freezing. Shipping waivers and winter shipping boxes are also available.
